SOUTHEASTERN & SOUTH CENTRAL COMPACTS' JOINT MEETING
Wilmington, North Carolina
Wednesday, June 5, 2024

<u>Call to Order</u> – The Meeting was called to order by Brandon Howard, Chair, Southeastern Compact.

<u>Introduction of Members Present</u> –All attendees made introductions, with all states being represented except West Virginia.

<u>Reading of Minutes of Previous Meeting and Approval</u> - Copies of the minutes of the previous meeting were distributed earlier via e-mail. A reading of the minutes was not necessary, and the minutes were approved.

<u>Compact Coordinator Report</u> - The June 2023 – May 2024 South Central and Southeastern Joint Forest Fire Compacts' Report was e-mailed by Jim Prevette.

The report stated that for CY 2023:

- The Southern Area had 92% of the ten-year average in fire numbers and 70% of the ten-year average of acres burned.
- The Southern Area's wildfire totals were 45% of the nation's total and accounted for 25% of the total acres.
- 49% of human caused fire in the nation occurred in the Southern Area.

June 2023 – May 2024 Compact Dispatches

This was an extremely busy year for the movement of compact resources. Both Compacts were activated twice for fire control and the Southeastern Compact was also activated for LE training.

Alliance of Forest Fire Compacts (AFFC)

The NASF Fire Committee is planning to assist in reestablishing the Alliance of Forest Fire Compacts and has offered to host the AFFC website.
